ORDER

The Hon'ble Appellate Tribunal for Electricity in its judgment dated 21st October, 2011 in Appeal No. 121 of 2010 and I.A. No. 83 of 2010 had directed this Commission to initiate the true-up exercise upto FY 2006-07 immediately in respect of the distribution companies namely Paschimanchal Vidyut Vitran Nigam Limited, Dakshinanchal Vidyut Vitran Nigam Limited, Purvanchal Vidyut Vitran Nigam Limited, Madhyanchal Vidyut Vitran Nigam Limited Uttar Pradesh Transmission Corporation Limited and Kanpur Electricity Supply Company Limited (hereinafter referred to as 'KESCO').

Further this Commission in an order dated 29th March, 2012 in respect of hearing held on 27th March, 2012 in the matter of Aggregate Revenue Requirement (ARR) and Tariff for FY 2010-11, FY 2011-12 & FY 2012-13 of KESCO had directed the distribution licensee to file the true-up petitions upto FY 2007-08. The relevant extract of this Commission's order is reproduced below:

"The Commission also directs all the Petitioners to file individual detailed True-up Petitions upto FY 2007-08 along with copies of audited accounts accompanied with schedules and CAG report for each of the previous financial years."



Accordingly, KESCO had filed a petition for True-up for the financial years 2000-01 to 2007-08 on 19th June, 2012.

Certain deficiencies were observed in the True-up petition filed by licensee. In this regard a deficiency note was issued by the Commission on 18th December, 2012 wherein the licensee was directed to provide its replies on the same by 2nd January, 2013. Thereafter, KESCO in a letter dated 17th January, 2013 had requested the Commission to grant extension of time limit by two weeks for submission of replies.

Subsequently on 23rd January, 2013, KESCO submitted its replies on the deficiencies. Most of the critical data as required by the Commission for the acceptance / admission of the true-up petition has been supplied by the licensee, and accordingly the Commission admits the petition submitted by KESCO for further processing.

The Commission hereby directs KESCO to publish Public Notice within 3 days from the issue of this order, detailing the salient information and facts of the True-up Petitions for FY 2000-01 to 2007-08 along with their website address in at least two daily newspapers (One English and One Hindi) for two successive days inviting views / comments / suggestions / objections / representations within 15 days from the date of publication of the Public Notice by all stakeholders and public at large. The Commission further directs KESCO to upload the submitted petitions along with the response to the deficiency note on their website for the same purpose.

The Commission reserves the right to seek any further information / clarifications as deemed necessary during the processing of this petition.
